

MINNESOTA SNAPSHOT

The population of Minnesota grew by 402,608, an increase of 7.59% from 2010. The state population is 5.7 million and more than 78 percent of the population growth over the past decade was in the Twin Cities metro. The Twin Cities Metro remained the nation's 16th most populated with 3,690,261 residents counted in the 2020 Census, that is a 356,628-person, or a 10.7 percent increase over the 2010 Census. That is faster than the overall national 7.4 percent growth rate. The Twin Cities metro placed right behind Seattle at 15 residents and ahead of San Diego at 17.
