Between 2010 and 2020, North Carolina's population grew from 9,535,483 to 10,439,483, an increase of 903,905 or 9.5%. Wake County officially surpassed Mecklenburg to become the most populous county in North Carolina. Rolesville, one of the 12 municipalities of Wake County certainly contributed to the growth as it saw a 150 percent growth in population and Raleigh still ranks second behind Charlotte in population.

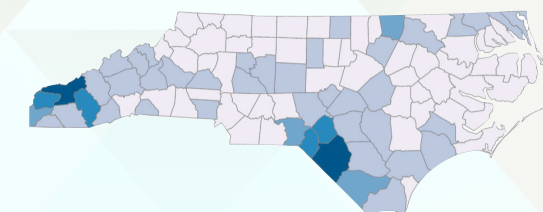
